The working group

In line with the guidelines on the composition of the Branch Committee, namely representing the diversity of industry operating in the state, the Board resolved on 14 November 2018 to set up a new Resource Recovery and Market Development Working Group under each State Branch Committee.

The Chair of the Resource Recovery and Market Development is expected to participate on the Branch Committee, either at the table or through the teleconference facility.

The working group will comprise a chair, vice chair, and working group members. Each Branch Committee will elect the Working Group chair and vice chair. Any WMAA member can participate in the Resource Recovery and Market Development as a working group member.

The chair of each State Remanufacturing Working Group will form the WMAA National Resource Recovery and Market Development Division and will meet once every two months for a WMAA National Division meeting.

Terms of Reference - Resource Recovery and Market Development Working Group

- (1) Monitor and identify current, emerging and longer-term issues and trends affecting the waste and resource recovery industry in the State, focusing on secondary remanufacturing and resource recovery. These include proposed changes to regulation and policy frameworks as well as secondary end-market opportunities.
- (2) Provide advice and, where appropriate, recommend action to the State Branch Committee on these issues, working with the Branch Committee to support WMAA advocacy activity within the state and subject matter, and where this is applicable, nationally.
- (3) Assist the State Branch Committee in the development of relevant submissions, policies, and reports.
- (4) Assist in developing and proposing topics/speakers for Branch seminars to support understanding/learning on current or emerging issues within remanufacturing and resource recovery.
- (5) Provide a forum for networking and sharing knowledge.
- (6) The Chair of the working group will organise working group meetings, formalise agendas, and take minutes.

(7) The Chair of the working group will collate and synthesise feedback and insight from Group representatives and disseminate this information at Branch Committee meetings or during the State and/or National submission process.
